## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a triangular shaped area of Amroth Close at its cul-de-sac termination point at Rednal, in the City of Birmingham.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by Birmingham City Council, under reference 2014/08832/PA.
