**BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2017**

Notice is hereby given that under the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, Bromsgrove District Council ("the Council") proposes to make the Bromsgrove District Council (Off- Street Parking Places) Order 2017 the effect of which will be:-

- To revoke the Bromsgrove District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2015 and introduce the Bromsgrove District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2017.
- To rename Bromsgrove Station Car Park as Aston Fields Car Park and Hanover Street Car Park as St John Street Car Park.
- To re-designate certain car parks as either long stay or short stay and amend the charging structure accordingly based on the existing tariffs.
- To make changes to the Schedule relating to parking permits including changes to certain fees and extending the use of permits to Parkside, New Road and Aston Fields Car Parks.
- To introduce the option of up to 2 hours parking at nil charge at Aston Fields Car Park.

It is intended that these arrangements shall come into effect on **01 April 2017**. The Order is available for inspection at the Customer Service Centre, Bromsgrove District Council, Parkside, Market Street, Bromsgrove B61 8DA from 09:00 to 17:00 Monday to Friday, or online at: www.bromsgrove.gov.uk/consultations
