TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a north western part width of Worcester Road adjoining the south eastern boundary of no.52 Worcester Road at Bromsgrove in the District of Bromsgrove.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by Bromsgrove District Council, under reference 17/0218.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at Bromsgrove District Council, Parkside, Market Street, Bromsgrove B61 8DA in the 28 days commencing on 26 October 2018, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the address stated below (quoting NATTRAN/WM/S247/3523).

Objections should be received by midnight on **23 November 2018**.
