TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a northern part width of Rubery Lane at the former Cock Inn at Rubery, in Birmingham.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by Birmingham City Council, under reference 2018/03511/PA.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at Frankley Library, Balam Wood School, New Street, Rubery, Birmingham B45 0EU in the 28 days commencing on 12 July 2019, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the address stated below (quoting NATTRAN/WM/S247/3827).
