**APPLICATION FOR A VARIATION OF PREMISES  
LICENCE TO BE GRANTED UNDER THE  
LICENSING ACT 2003**

Abdul Muhith of Spices Indian Bangladeshi Cuisine, 151 Golden Cross Lane, Catshill, Worcestershire B61 0JZ proposes to make the following variations to their premises license:

Change license hours to 12.00-23.00 every day (currently 17.30-23.00). Sell alcohol both on and off the premises (currently on premises only). Sell alcohol both inside and outside of their restaurant by providing tables and chairs directly in front of the restaurant where customers can enjoy a drink while waiting for a take away meal.
