Proposal: The bridge has recently been stabilised and stonework restored and repaired under 21/00188/LBC Brockhill Bridge. The bridge is to remain in the grounds and long term ownership of HM Prison Hewell but is NOT to be used as

a crossing for either pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

An existing internal road and secure fenced area

to the west of the pedestrian bridge means it is not

possible to create a graded access which would

have existed at the time of the original construction.

As such there is a significant fall (over 1m) from the bridge exit to the existing ground and the repaired stonework is exposed on this western approach. A new retaining wall, using White Hollington as coping stone, standing proud of the structure and backfilled with aggregate will prevent access to the bridge from this direction. A membrane will protect the original stonework and as this will be technically touching the original stonework, LBC is being sought. Drainage will also be incorporated

On the eastern approach, the existing land grades up to the entrance of the bridge as it would have originally done. The proposal is to tidy up the approach with a resin bound gravel that matches the decking (Sureset Golden Pearl). To prevent accidental pedestrian access and the risk of a fall on the western side, a secure palisade fence is proposed which stands proud of the bridge and does not interfere with the existing structure. The height will be restricted to the height of the existing railings so that it does not dominate
