TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of two northern part-widths of Donegal Close and a north-eastern part-width of Donegal Close, comprising highway verge, at Coventry in the City of Coventry.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by Coventry City Council, under reference FUL/2015/4174.

Copies of the draft Order and relevant plan will be available for inspection during normal opening hours at Charter Sub Post Office, 290 Charter Avenue, Coventry, CV4 8DA in the 28 days commencing on 01 December 2016, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the address stated below (quoting NATTRAN/WM/S247/2553).
