

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -SECTION 14(1)(a) THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 3 TO JUNCTION 4) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable renewal works to be carried out to the electronic traffic detector system.

- The effect of the Order will be to close—
 (1) the northbound carriageway of the M6
- from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 3 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 4;

 (2) the slip road leading to the northbound
- (2) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 3;
- (3) the slip roads leading to and from the northbound carriageway of the M6, to and from Corley Motorway Service Area, northwest of Junction 3.

The work will be carried out overnight between 22:00 hours and 05:00 hours and is expected to start on Wednesday 8 February 2017 and continue for three nights. The Order will come into force on 3 February 2017.

Vehicles being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures. A diversion route via the A46, A45, A452 and A446 will be signed.
