## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COMMON LANE. STONEL FIGH

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Common Lane, Stoneleigh from its junction with Bubbenhall Lane to a point outside Black Spinney, a distance of approximately 180 metres. to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate ducting works

The Order will commence on 28 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 August 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Common Lane, Bubbenhall Road, Chantry Heath Lane (and vice versa).
