

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984-  
SECTION 14(1)(a)****THE A45 TRUNK ROAD  
(TOLLBAR END ROUNDABOUT TO  
RYTON ROUNDABOUT, WARWICKSHIRE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)  
ORDER 2017**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the A45 Trunk Road, in the County of Warwickshire to allow road markings and road stud replacement works to be carried out. The effect of the Order will be to -

1. close, at different times –
  - a) the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A45, from its roundabout junction with the A46 Coventry Eastern Bypass and the B4110, and Rowley Road, known as Tollbar End Roundabout, to its roundabout junction with the A445, Leamington Road and Wolston Lane, known as Ryton Roundabout, at Ryton on Dunsmore; and
  - b) the link roads leading to and from the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A45 to and from the roundabout junction with the A423;
2. prohibit –
  - a) any vehicle from entering or leaving the lengths of the A45 described in 1.a) above, at its junction with High Street, Brandon Lane and Church Road; and
  - b) vehicles from entering or proceeding through the gap in the central reservation opposite its junction with High Street and Church Road of the A45.

The work will be carried out overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Tuesday 22 August 2017 and continue for 16 nights. The Order will come into force on Friday 18 August 2017.

Vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures and prohibitions. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Diversion routes via the A445, A452, and A46 and vice versa will be signed.

(JUNCTION 4 TO JUNCTION 2,  
WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY  
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable cyclic maintenance works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close –

1. the slip roads –
  - a) leading to and from the northbound and southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junctions 2 and 3;
  - b) to and from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4; and
  - c) to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4.

Work will be carried out overnight between 22:00 hours and 05:00 hours and is expected to start on Sunday 20 August 2017 and continue for nine nights. The Order will come into force on 14 August 2017.

Vehicles being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures.

A diversion route via an alternative junction will be signed.
