

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATION ROAD, FILLONGLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Station Road, Fillongley from a point approximately 9 metres south of Devitts Green Lane junction to a point opposite the junction of Stonehouse Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to prove, locate and clear blockages and cable in existing duct in the verge and carriageway.

The Order will commence on 3 December 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Station Road, Spring Hill, Stonehouse Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF OLD HOUSE LANE, CORLEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Old House Lane, Corley from the junction of Tamworth Road to a point approximately 300 metres from Radford, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to clear duct blockages.

The Order will commence on 23 November 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Tamworth Road, Church Lane, Old House Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BLACK HALL LANE, FILLONGLEY

The Order will commence on 23 November 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 November 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Mill Lane, Tamworth Road, Black Hall Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GREEN END ROAD, FILLONGLEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Green End Road, Fillongley from the junction of Meriden Road to the junction of NewHall Green Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the clearance of blockages.

The Order will commence on 18 November 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 November 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Green End Road, Meriden Road, Fillongley Road, Hampton Lane, Birmingham Road, Maxstoke Lane, Packington Lane, Church Lane (and vice versa).
