ROAD TRAFFIC REGIJI ATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF

SANDY LANE, FILLONGLEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Sandy Lane, Fillongley from a point outside Kelmarsh, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a duct and power cable.

The Order will commence on 30 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 February 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via:

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STONEY LANE, FILLONGLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Stoney Lane, Fillongley from Outswood Lane junction to the junction of Green End Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to allow engineers to access the overhead network.

The Order will commence on 5 February 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7 February 2018.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Green End Road, Meriden Road, Fillongley Road, Kinwalsey Lane, Stoney Lane (and vice versa).
