(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M6 Motorway, near Corley, in the County of Warwickshire, to allow resurfacing work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close the southbound carriageway of the M6 from a point 1 kilometre east of the centreline of the B4102 Meriden Road underbridge to a point 500 metres west of the centreline of the B4098 Tamworth Road underbridge, near Corley, and allow traffic to run on the hard shoulder.

The work will be carried out overnight between 22:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Saturday 17 February 2018 and continue for eleven nights. The Order will come into force on Monday 12 February 2018.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes, will be exempt from the closure.
