

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
M282 FILLONGLEY PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION  
ORDER 2017**

On 17 April 2018 Warwickshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed will **DIVERT Footpath** M282 from Point A (GR 42528 28569) running generally ENE for approx. 623m to Point X on Green End Lane (GR 42580 28602) **TO A LINE** commencing at Point A (GR 42528 28569) running generally NE to Point B (GR 42552 28587), N to Point C (GR 42552 28595), NE to Point D (GR 42565 28606), SE to Point E (GR 42569 28601) and NE to Green End Lane at Point Y (GR 42574 28607), as shown on the Order Plan, a total distance of approx. 715m. The new path will have a width of 2m.

A copy of the Order and the Order Plan have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Warwickshire County Council, Shire Hall, Market Square, Warwick CV34 4SA from 8am - 5.30pm on weekdays, (5pm Fridays) and 9am - 4pm Saturdays. The Order comes into force on 24 April 2018, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or if any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 19 April 2018, make an application to the High Court.
