

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHAWBURY LANE, FILLONGLEY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Shawbury Lane, Fillongley from a point south of Hill View to a point opposite The Elms, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a duct.

The Order will commence on 21 June 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 June 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Shawbury Lane, Daw Mill Lane, Newtown Lane, Pump Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – SURFACE DRESSING 2018 – WARWICKSHIRE NORTH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing the roads as indicated in the schedule below to vehicular traffic.

The closures are required to facilitate carriageway surface dressing works.

Please note: 10MPH Speed restrictions will be imposed for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on the carriageway, whilst work for surface dressing is being carried out and for a short period afterwards as indicated by signage.

The Order will commence on 28 June 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the all works will be completed on or before 30 September 2018.

Please note: The dates as indicated in the schedule are estimated dates and may be subject to change i.e. inclement weather or other mitigating circumstances. All closures will be indicated by signage – advance signage will be in place as appropriate.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
