

## **LICENSING ACT 2003**

Application has been made by Marston's PLC to the Licensing Authority of Coventry City Council to vary the Premises Licence for the Vale at Nod Rise, Coventry, CV5 7ND. The application includes the following terms:-

1. To change the internal and external layout of the premises as per the plan deposited with the Licensing Authority.
2. To enhance hours for licensable activities of retail sale of alcohol, regulated entertainment and late night refreshment on Friday and Saturday to 01.00.
3. To permit additional licensable activities of live music, recorded music and dancing to the same hours as retail sale of alcohol.
4. To delete and add revised conditions.
5. To allow licensable activities on New Year's Eve until 01:00 on 2nd January.
