## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF NEWHALL GREEN LANE, FILLONGLY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Newhall Green Lane, Fillongly, from the jct. Meriden Road to the jct. with Green End Lane, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for carriageway patching and associated works, 08.00 to 16.00 daily.

The Order will commence on 6 August 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7 August 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Newhall Green Lane, Green End Road, Meriden Road and vice versa.

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 16A

### SPECIAL EVENTS ORDER – B4428 COVENTRY ROAD, BINLEY WOODS

Warwickshire County Council has made a Special Events Order closing B4428 Coventry Road, Binley Woods to all vehicular traffic, between B4209 and Coombe Abbey Park entrance save for vehicular traffic that is using the B4428 Coventry Road to leave Coombe Weekender ("the Event") and restricting the speed of all traffic permitted to use the B4428 to 30mph.

The closure and speed restriction is required to create a safe environment for egress of crowds from the Event at Coombe Abbey.

The Order will commence on 3 August 2019 and will last for a period of 3 days, or until the Event is completed, whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that the road will be closed from 21.00hrs on 3 August 2019 until dispersal of crowds by approximately 01.00hrs on 4 August 2019.

The Order contains exemptions which apply to the police, the emergency services and to statutory undertakers. Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Brinklow Road, Harvesters Close, Clifford Bridge Road, Brandon Road, Harry Weston Road, Skipworth Road, A46 from jct A428 to jct. B4082 Ne, Coventry Eastern Bypass, A46 jct. A428 roundabout, Rugby Road, Bretford Road, Queens Road, Fosse Way, Coventry Road (and vice versa).
