ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BROAD LANE & FILLONGLEY ROAD, FILLONGLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside Chapel House to the junction at Broad Lane/Hardingwood Lane.

Reason for Order: To safely facilitate utility works.

Order Commences: 3 February 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 14 February 2020.

Access & Diversion: Broad Lane, Shawbury Lane, Cow Lane, Kingshill Lane, Fillongley Road, Bentley Lane, Green End Road, Hardingwood Lane and vice versa.

D524 TIPPERS HILL LANE, FILLONGLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between C12 Station Road and to D471 Lamp Lane.

Reason for Order: To safely facilitate bridge parapet repairs.

Order Commences: 3 February 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 7 February 2020.

Access & Diversion: Lamp Lane, B4102 Nuneaton Road, B4098 Tamworth Road, Station Road and vice versa.

MILL LANE, HOOD LANE ANSLEY

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows:

Mill Lane – from the junction at Wood Lane to a point outside Ansley Mill.

Hood Lane – from the junction at Ansley Lane to the junction at Mill lane.

Reason for Order: To safely facilitate utility works.

Order Commences: 5 February 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 18 February 2020.

Access & Diversion: Mill Lane, Nuneaton Road, Tamworth Road, Wood Lane, Woodside, Oak Avenue, Rectory Road, Ansley Lane, Birmingham Road (and vice versa).

GROVE ROAD, ANSTY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Main Road.

Reason for Order: To facilitate carriageway patching and associated works.

Access/egress to Meadow Close and The Close maybe affected while works are in progress.

Order Commences: 14 February 2020 for 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 14 February 2020 between 08.00hrs and 16.00hrs.

Access & Diversion: Access/egress to Meadow Close, The Row and Alphabet Lodge may be affected while works are in progress.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
