

Notice of application to vary a Premises Licence under Section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003

Notice is hereby given that Casual Dining Services Limited in respect of Premises known as Café Rouge (to be known as The Mulberry), Belgrade Plaza, Upper Well Street, Coventry, CV1 4AH has applied to Coventry City Council for a Variation of a Premises Licence.
