ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BERRYFIELDS & SANDY LANE, FILLONGLEY

Order Effects: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows:

Berryfields – from a point outside 1 Preachers homes to a point outside Little Orchard (approx 100 metres).

Sandy Lane – from its junction with Nuneaton Road to its junction with Wood End Lane.

Reason for Order: To safely facilitate (phased) utility works.

Order Commences: 10 February 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 21 February 2020.

Access & Diversions:

1. Berryfields, Nuneaton Road and vice versa.
2. Sandy Lane, Nuneaton Road, Coventry Road, Wood End Lane and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

KINGSWOOD AVENUE, CORLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To facilitate renewal of a water pipe.

Order Commences: 27 February 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 2 March 2020.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STARETON LANE, STONELEIGH) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020; AND THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STARETON LANE/B4113 STONELEIGH ROAD, STONELEIGH) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS) ORDER 2020

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:-

- i. introduce a one way traffic flow upon Stareton Lane, Stoneleigh, as described in Schedule 1 below; and
- ii. introduce a right turn ban as described in Schedule 2 below.

A copy of the proposed Orders, together with a plan showing the lengths of roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; at the Warwick District Council, Riverside House, Milverton Hill, Leamington Spa and at the Library & Information Centre at Royal Pump Rooms, The Parade, Leamington Spa during usual opening hours.

PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN

Stareton Lane, Stoneleigh

No right turn from Stareton Lane onto the B4113 Stoneleigh Road, Stoneleigh.
