ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

KAREEN GROVE, BINLEY WOODS

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Oakdale Road to the end of the Grove.

Reason for Order: Footway reconstruction and associated works, 08.00hrs-17.00hrs on weekdays only.

Order Commences: 30 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

NEWALL GREEN LANE, FILLONGLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Green End Road and Green End Lane.

Reason for Order: Works for the replacement of a BT pole.

Anticipated Completion: between 08.00hrs-16.00hrs on 29 July 2020.

Access & Diversion: Newhall Green Lane, Green End Road, Stoney Lane, Gorseley Green Lane, Green End Lane and vice versa.

STONELEIGH ROAD, KENILWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from Dalehouse Lane roundabout to a point outside Stuarts Fruit & Vegetable wholesalers.

Order Commences: 27 July 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 14 September 2020.
