

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (STONELEIGH, WARWICKSHIRE)
(LINK ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an Order on the A46 Trunk Road, at Stoneleigh, in the County of Warwickshire, to allow street lighting installation works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A46, to Stoneleigh Road, at Stoneleigh.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 05:45 hours and is expected to start on Tuesday 10 November 2020 and continue for 2 nights. The Order will come into force on 3 November 2020.

Vehicles being used by police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closure.

A diversion route via an alternative junction of the A46/A452 roundabout junction will be signed.

THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 1 TO JUNCTION 2)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an Order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, to allow road joint replacement works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close various lanes of –

- a) the southbound carriageway of the M6 from a point 1.3 kilometres east of its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2, for a distance of 1.8 kilometres; and
 - b) the northbound carriageway of the M6 from a point 600 metres northwest of the centreline of the B4455 Fosse Way overbridge, for a distance of 1.8 kilometres.
- and allow traffic to run on the hard shoulder.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 05:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 9 November 2020 and continue for one month. The Order will come into force on 2 November 2020.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.
