ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

NEWHALL GREEN LANE, FILLONGLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the junction with Green End Road to Meriden Road.

Reason for Order: To safely facilitate works for the replacement of BT Poles, 08.00hrs-16.30hrs.

Order Commences: 26 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 26 November 2020.

Access & Diversion: Newhall Green Lane, Green End Road, Meriden Road and vice versa.

SOLOMONS TEMPLE LANE, FILLONGLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Green End Road and Culvers Lane.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 08.00hrs-16.00hrs.

Order Commences: 20 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 20 November 2020.

Access & Diversion: Culvers Lane and Green End Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STARETON LANE, STONELEIGH) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020; AND THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STARETON LANE/B4113 STONELEIGH ROAD, STONELEIGH) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS) ORDER 2020

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to:-

- i. introduce a one way traffic flow upon Stareton Lane, Stoneleigh, as described in Schedule 1 below; and
- ii. introduce a right turn ban as described in Schedule 2 below.

The Orders commence on Monday 30 November 2020.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Orders apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1 **ONE WAY TRAFFIC FLOW**

Stareton Lane, Stoneleigh

From its junction with the B4113 Stoneleigh Road, eastwards for a distance of 80 metres – proposed one way traffic flow in a westerly direction only.

SCHEDULE 2 **PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN**

Stareton Lane, Stoneleigh

No right turn from Stareton Lane onto the B4113 Stoneleigh Road, Stoneleigh.
