

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)(a)**THE M6 MOTORWAY****(JUNCTION 3) (SLIP ROAD) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable street lighting and sign installation works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 3.

The work is expected to be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 1 February 2021 and continue for two nights. The Order will come into force on 25 January 2021.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closure.

A diversion route via M6 Junction 4 will be signed.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 14(1)(b) AND 122A**THE A45 TRUNK ROAD****(BETWEEN STIVCHALL AND TOLLBAR END) (CONNECTING ROADS) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an Order on the A45 Trunk Road, in the City of Coventry and the County of Warwickshire, due to the construction of a new junction.

The effect of the Order will be to impose a 50 miles per hour speed restriction on lengths of the new connecting roads at the new grade separated junction on the A45 between Stivichall and Tollbar End -

- a) a length of the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A45, from a point 100 metres east of the tip of the nosing at its junction with the A45, to that tip of the nosing;
- b) a length of the link road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A45, from a point 65 metres west of the tip of the nosing at its junction with the A45, to that tip of the nosing; and
- c) a length of the exit slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A45, from the tip of the nosing at its junction with the A45, to a point 159 metres west of that tip of the nosing.

The speed limit will be in operation 24 hours a day from 00:01 hours on Monday 8 February 2021. The Order will come into force on Friday 5 February 2021 and have a maximum duration of 18 months.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance and special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions.
