

**HIGHWAYS ENGLAND ORDER

**The A45 and A46 Trunk Roads (Stivichall Interchange)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021**

Made 2021
Coming into force 2021

Highways England Company Limited(a), being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of trunk road and one of those connecting roads, at Stivichall, in the City of Coventry and the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

Highways England Company Limited, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as The A45 and A46 Trunk Roads (Stivichall Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021 and shall come into force on Friday 16th April 2021.

2. In this Order:

“Stivichall Interchange” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A45 slip roads, the A46 slip roads, the A444 slip roads and Leaf Lane, at Stivichall;

“the trunk road” means a length of Stivichall Interchange from its junction with the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46, to its junction with the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A45;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A46 to Stivichall Interchange;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 23 April 2021 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

(a) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
