

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -
SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 2,
WARWICKSHIRE) (SLIP ROADS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable traffic signs installation works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close, at different times, –

- (1) the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2; and
- (2) the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Thursday 4 November 2021 and continue for twenty-two nights. The closure of the southbound exit slip will only be in operation for short periods only whilst traffic management is installed/removed. The Order will come into force on 1 November 2021.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via alternative junctions of the M6 will be signed.
