ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

HEATHER ROAD, BINLEY WOODS

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Oakdale and Birchwood Road.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the renewal of a water main.

Order Commences: 20 December 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 20 January 2022.

Access & Diversion: Birchwood Road, Rugby Road, Oakdale Road, Heather Road and vice versa.

C12 STATION ROAD, ARLEY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Spring Hill and Tamworth Road.

Order Commences: 4 January 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 17 January 2022.
