

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -
SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE M6 MOTORWAY (M6 JUNCTION 2,
WARWICKSHIRE) (SLIP ROADS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an order on the M6 Motorway, near Ansty, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable pre-message sign installation works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close –

- (1) the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2; and
- (2) the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 10 January 2022 and continue for twelve nights. The Order will come into force on 3 January 2022.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via the M6 Junction 1 and the M6 Junction 3 will be signed.
