

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)(a) THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 1 TO JUNCTION 2, WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire to enable bridge repair works to be carried out

The effect of the Order will be to close -

- (1) the northbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 1, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2; and
- (2) the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 1.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 21 March 2022 and continue for six nights. The Order will come into force on 14 March 2022.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures
