ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

STONELEIGH ROAD, BAGINGTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: Carriageway resurfacing works.

Order Commences: 3 May 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 3 May 2022.

Access & Diversion: Chantry Heath Lane, Bubbenhall Road, Orchard Way, Rowley Road, Coventry Road and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

NEW ROAD, ASH GREEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Ash Grove and Corley View.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the permanent reinstatement of Virgin Media trench in the footway and carriageway.

Order Commences: 18 May 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 20 May 2022.

Access & Diversion: New Road, Ash Green Lane, Wheelwright Lane, Nunts Lane, Parkville Highway, Beake Avenue, The Scotchill, Bennetts Road South, Bennetts Road, Exhall Road and vice versa.

Contractor: Comex 2000, Tel: 0800 819 9001.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
