

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (SHERBOURNE TO STIVICHALL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an Order on the A46 Trunk Road, between Sherbourne and Stoneleigh, in the County of Warwickshire and the City of Coventry, to allow cyclical maintenance works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close, at different times, –

- (1) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A429, the M40 Junction 15 slip roads and Stratford Road (M40 Junction 15 Roundabout), to its roundabout junction with the B4463 and Stratford Road, at Sherbourne (Sherbourne Roundabout);
- (2) the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Sherbourne Roundabout, to its junction with the entry slip road leading from M40 Junction 15 Roundabout;
- (3) any slip road or link road leading to or from the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the link road leading to Stoneleigh Road at Stoneleigh, to its junction with Sherbourne Roundabout;
- (4) any slip road or link road leading to or from the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Sherbourne Roundabout, to its junction with the entry slip road leading from Stoneleigh Road, at Stoneleigh;
- (5) any layby adjacent to the northbound or southbound carriageway of the A46 between Sherbourne Roundabout and its junction with the A444, at Stivichall; and
- (6) any layby adjacent to the slip roads leading to and from the A46, to and from M40 Junction 15 Roundabout;

The work will be carried out overnight, on week days only, between 21:00 hours and 05:30 hours and is expected to start on Tuesday 17 May 2022 and continue for approximately three weeks. The Order will come into force on 13 May 2022.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via the M40 Junction 15 Roundabout and alternative junctions of the A46 will be signed.

THE M6 AND M69 MOTORWAYS AND THE A46 TRUNK
ROAD (M6 JUNCTION 2) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M6 Motorway, the M69 Motorway and the A46 Trunk Road, in the County of Warwickshire, to allow resurfacing, sign installation and associated works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to, at different times, –

- (1) impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on –
 - (a) the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2; and
 - (b) the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A46, the A4600, the B4065 and the M6 Junction 2 slip roads (M6 Junction 2 Roundabout); and
- (2) close –
 - (a) the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M69, to the northbound carriageway of the M6 and to the M6 Junction 2 roundabout;
 - (b) the northbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 1, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2;
 - (c) the southbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 2, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 1;
 - (d) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 1;
 - (e) any slip road leading to or from the M6 at Junction 2;
 - (f) the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A46 to M6 Junction 2 Roundabout; and
 - (g) the circulatory carriageway of the M6 Junction 2 Roundabout;

The work is expected to start on Thursday 5 May 2022 and continue for approximately three months. The closures will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 06:00 hours. The speed restriction will be in force from 21:00 hours on Thursday 5 May 2022, for twenty-four hours per day, for the duration of the works. The order will come into force on 2 May 2022.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restriction and closures. Vehicles being used for special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restriction and vehicles being used by for traffic officer purposes, being used in connection with the works or being used for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes using the A5, the A426, the B4065, the B4029, the B4027, the A428, the A444, the A4600 and alternative junctions of the A46, the M6 and the M69 will be signed.
