THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTIONS
1 - 16) AND CONNECTING ROADS
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National

Highways Limited (Company No. 09346363) intends to revoke existing Orders and make a new Order on the M6 Motorway, in the Metropolitan Boroughs of Solihull, Sandwell and Walsall, the City of Birmingham and in the Counties of Warwickshire, Staffordshire and Leicestershire, to enable maintenance and improvement works, to be carried out in safety.

The works are expected to take place overnight between 19:00 and 06:00 (07:00 on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Tuesday 3 January 2023 and ending on Saturday 23 December 2023.

The effect of the Order will be to impose

prohibitions on the following lengths of carriageway: (i) the northbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the A14, near

- Catthorpe, to its junction with the A14, hear Catthorpe, to its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 16;

 (ii) the southbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the entry slip
- the A14, near Catthorpe;
 (iii) any slip road or link road leading to
 and from the lengths of carriageway
 described in (i) and (ii) above; and

road at Junction 16, to its junction with

(iv) any emergency refuge area adjacent to the lengths of carriageway described in (i) and (ii) above.

During any road closures traffic will be

diverted via alternative junctions of the M6 Motorway and local roads. These diversions will be clearly indicated by traffic signs throughout the area. To obtain a copy of the M6 Programme of Works please contact the National Highways Customer Contact Centre on 0300 123 5000

The duration of each prohibition will vary depending upon the nature of the work being undertaken on each occasion.

The prohibitions will not apply to
emergency services, works, winter
maintenance, or traffic officer vehicles.
The prohibitions will only apply during

such times and to such extent as shall be

indicated by traffic signs.

The Order comes into force on 27 December 2022 and will expire on

27 December 2022 and will expire or 23 December 2023.
