Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

B4065 HINCKLEY ROAD, ANSTY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To safely enable resurfacing works on National Highways network.

(BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION J) ORDER 2023 (COMBE FIELDS ROAD AND PILOT WAY, NEAR ANSTY) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the above-named Orders, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

- to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in Schedule 1 below;
- Vary the existing 50mph Speed limit and impose a 40mph speed limit in its place on the length of road described in Schedule 2 below; and
- to impose a 40mph limit on the length of road described in Schedule 3 below.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule 1 below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

SCHEDULE 1 (PROPOSED NO WAITING AT ANY TIME)

COMBE FIELDS ROAD AND PILOT WAY, NEAR ANSTY

1. Combe Fields Road – No Waiting at Any Time

Both sides of the carriageway, from a point 152 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Peter Hall Lane to a point 64 metres south of the centreline of its junction with Peter Hall Lane.

2. New Access Road/Pilot Way – No Waiting at Any Time

Both sides of the carriageway, from its junction with Combe Fields Road in a south-westerly direction for 20 metres.

SCHEDULE 2 EXISTING 50PH LIMIT REDUCED TO 40MPH

Combe Fields Road, Near Ansty

From a point 353 metres northwest of the centreline of the junction with Peter Hall Lane to a point 254 metres south of the junction with Peter Hall Lane, a distance of 607 metres.

SCHEDULE 3 40MPH SPEED LIMIT

Pilot Way, Near Ansty

From the centreline of its junction with Combe Fields Road for a distance of 23.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
