

- SECTION 14(1)(a) **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -**THE M69 MOTORWAY AND THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (COMBE FIELDS TO SHILTON, WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M69

Motorway and the A46 Trunk Road, between Combe Fields and Shilton, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable resurfacing and maintenance works to be carried out. The effect of the Order, will be to, at different times

- (1) impose a 50 miles per hour speed restriction on -
- (a) the southbound carriageway of the M69 between points 150 metres north and 600 metres south of the centreline of Wood Lane overbridge, at Shilton;
- (2) impose a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on
 - (a) the northbound carriageway of the M69 from its junction with the A46, to a point 800 metres north of the centreline of the B4065 overbridge, at Ansty;
 - (b) the southbound carriageway of the M69 from a point 600 metres south of the centreline of Wood Lane overbridge, to its junction with the A46;
 - (c) the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Walsgrave Roundabout, to it junction with the M69;
 - (d) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the M69 to a point 500 metres north of its junction with Walsgrave Roundabout, and
 - (e) a length of the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M69 to the M6 at Junction 2 and its roundabout junction with the A46, the B4065, the M6 slip roads and Hinckley Road, from its junction with the M69 for a distance of 100 metres;
- (3) close
 - (a) the northbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 800 metres north of its junction with Walsgrave Roundabout, to its junction with the M69; and
 - (b) the northbound carriageway of the M69 from its junction with the A46 to a point 100 metres north of the centreline of the B4065 overbridge;

and allow traffic to use the offside lane of the southbound carriageway of the M69 and the southbound carriageway of the A46 in a northerly direction, in a contraflow manner;

- (4) close the link road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A46, to the westbound carriageway of the A46 Coventry Eastern Bypass, at Ansty; and
- (5) close the laybys adjacent to the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A46 approximately 500 metres south of the centreline of Farber Road overbridge.

The work is expected to start on Wednesday 31 May 2023 and continue for approximately eleven weeks. The speed restrictions, contraflow and closures will be in operation for twenty-four hours per day for the duration of the works. The Order will come into force on 24 May 2023. Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority or

ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restriction and closures. Vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures and vehicles being used for special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions.

A diversion route for the slip road closure via the M69 Junction will be signed.

SECTION 14(1)(A) AND (7) THE A45 TRUNK ROAD (THURLASTON, WARWICKSHIRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC IN LAYBY) **ORDER 2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an order on the A45 Trunk Road, the County of Warwickshire, to allow utility works to be carried out.
