is the B4029 where it joins the B4065, to a point 17.25 metres southwest, then in westerly direction for a further 16m.

SCHEDULE 2 B4065 Main Road and B4065, Ansty (DYL to both sides of the road) From the centre of the running carriageway (ii)

- that is the B4029 where is joins the B4065, to a point 85m south west of that point. (Excepting a 16m length [layby] from a point 17.25m south west of the B4029 carriageway centre). From the centre of the running carriageway (iii)
- that is the B4029 where is joins the B4065, to a point 155m north north east of that point
- The B4029, from the Back of Highway (BoH) on the south east side of the B4065, in a south , in a south easterly direction for a distance of 88m.
