

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D34610 BUCHANAN ROAD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Ferndown Court and Bracken Drive.

Order Effect: Cycleway closed to ALL traffic from a point opposite the junction of Churchill Road to the junction of Alfred Green Close.

Reason for Order: To enable works laying duct in the footway & verge, 09.00hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commences: 21 August 2023 for up to 6 months.

Anticipated Completion: 1 September 2023.
