

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (STONELEIGH, WARWICKSHIRE) (50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

National Highways Limited (Company no. 9346363) hereby gives notice that it has made an Order under sections 84(1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A46 Trunk Road at Stoneleigh in the County of Warwickshire.

The effect of the Order, which comes into force on 1 December 2023, is to impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on –

- (a) the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A46, between points 25 metres and 93 metres northeast of the roundabout junction with Stoneleigh Road at Stoneleigh (the roundabout); and
 (b) the entry slip road leading to the
- (b) the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46, between points 14 metres and 64 metres southwest of the roundabout. A copy of the Order, together with a plan
