



**Rugby Borough Council
Notice of Intended Disposal of
Open Space Land
Local Government Act 1972
Section 123(2A)**

In accordance with section 123(2A) of the Local Government Act 1972 as amended), notice is hereby given that Rugby Borough Council intends to dispose of a parcel of land comprising The Queen's Diamond Jubilee Centre and Athletics Track, and adjacent car parking area off Bruce Williams Way, Rugby, which consists of open space land. The land is intended to be disposed of by way of a lease for seven years and three months from 1 January 2024 to 31 March 2031 to Greenwich Leisure Limited (GLL) and used for the purpose of an accessible and affordable recreation, sport or leisure facility for the use of the local community.
