ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

A426 SOUTHAM ROAD, LEAMINGTON HASTINGS

Order Effect: A 40mph speed limit will be imposed, between the junctions of Hospital Lane and Birdingbury Lane.

Reason for Order: For the safety of all road users and of the Contractors working to replace the old water main.

Order Commences: 5 February 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 17 May 2024.

CAWSTON LANE, DUNCHURCH

Order Effect: Road closed between Coventry Road and Thurlaston Drive.

Reason for Order: Works to locate existing services in carriageway.

Order Commences: 3 February 2024 for up to 18 months.

Access & Diversion: Cawston Lane, Northampton Lane, Alwyn Road, Coventry Road and vice versa.

D30180 BACK LANE, LONG LAWFORD

Order Effect: Road closed between Railway Street and Tee Tong Road.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching works, closed 08.00hrs-16.00hrs.

Order Commences: 5 February 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 5 February 2024.

Access & Diversion: Back Lane, A428, Townsend Lane, School Street and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
