ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

CHURCH STREET, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To safely enable works for stop tap repair.

Order Commences: 10 March 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 10 March 2024.

Access & Diversion: Church Street, North Street, Evreux Way, Corporation Street, Warwick Street, Footpath at Warwick Street Subway, Lawrence Sheriff Street, Hillmorton Road, Whitehall Road, Clifton Road and vice versa.

CORONATION ROAD, CHURCH LAWFORD

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between points either side of the railway bridge.

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: Works to install vehicle impact fencing on the road.

Access & Diversion: Limestone Hall Lane, Coventry Road, Fosse Way, Coalpit Lane, Ling Lane and vice versa.

Order Effect: Roads closed as follows: **D3241 Lower Hillmorton Road** – between Langton Road and Loverock Crescent.

D3279 Kingsley Avenue – closed between Lower Hillmorton Road and Edgecote Close.
