

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

MAIN STREET, EATHORPE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for installation of a new water connection from main.

Order Commences: 9 April 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 11 April 2024.

Access & Diversion: Old Fosse Way, Fosse Way, Oxford Road, Leamington Road, Main Street and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

A425 LEAMINGTON ROAD, SOUTHAM

Order Effect: A 30 mph Speed Limit will be imposed from a point 30 metres west of the junction of Leamington Road and Hartley Gardens, where the current 50 mph starts, to a point 100 metres west of the River Itchen Bridge joining into HS2 existing 30 mph speed limited area.

Reason for Order: For the safety of all road users while HS2 works are in progress.

Order Commences: 22 April 2024 until such time as the Works have been completed and the Order has been revoked.

THORNTONS LANE & NAPTON HOLT ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic from outside Brook End Farm to the junction of Napton Holt Road.

Order Commences: 22 April 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 14 June 2024.

Access & Diversion: Holt Road, Welsh Road East, Priors Marston Road, Welsh Road, Southam Road, The Holloway, Shuckburgh Road, Butt Hill, Vicarage Road, Hackwell Street, High Street, New Street, Chapel Green Road, Thorntons Lane and vice versa.

POPLAR ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: Road works to enable fibre connection.

Order Commences: 22 April 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 23 April 2024.

Access & Diversion: Poplar Road, School Hill, Vicarage Road, Butt Hill, Southam Road, Brickyard Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 20 mph speed limit on the length of road mentioned in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 8 April 2024.

SCHEDULE

- Welsh Road West, Southam
From a point 9.5m west of the back of footway on the western side of Coventry Street, to a point 9m west of the western property boundary line of No 87 Welsh Road West. A distance of 795m.
- St James Road, Southam
Whole length.
- Park Lane, Southam
Whole length whole length except, from the back of footway on the western side of Market Hill, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 22m.

SCHEDULE

- Daventry Street, Southam
From the back of footway on the eastern side of Market Hill, eastwards for a distance of 8 metres.
- Meadow Road, Southam
From the back of footway on the eastern side of Coventry Street, eastwards for a distance of 18 metres.
- Oxford Street/Market Hill/High Street/Coventry Street (including the junction of Warwick Street), Southam
From a point in Oxford Street which is situate 44 metres north-west of its junction with Pendicke Street (measured from a point in line with the back of footway on the south-eastern side of Pendicke Street), northwards through Oxford Street, Market Hill, High Street and Coventry Street for a total distance of 590 metres in length.
- Park Lane, Southam
From the back of footway on the western side of Market Hill, north-westwards for a distance of 22 metres.
- Welsh Road West, Southam
From the back of footway on the western side of Coventry Street, westwards for a distance of 9.5 metres.
