

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BUTT HILL, NAPTON ON THE HILL & PARK LANE AND SAWBRIDGE ROAD, LOWER SHUCKBURGH

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows; **Phase 1 Butt Hill** – from the junction of Stockton Road to the junction of Southam Road, **Phase 2 Park Lane** in its entirety, **Phase 3 Sawbridge Road** from its junction with A425 to a point 300 metres past the Oxford Canal Bridge.

Reason for Order: To enable phased works for the replacement of a water main.

Order Commences: 28 May 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 14 June 2025.

Access & Diversion: For Butt Hill – Stockton Road, Napton Road, High Street, Southam Road, Southam By Pass, Daventry Road and vice versa.

For Park lane – There is no available diversion, vehicular access will be maintained where safe and possible to do so.

For Sawbridge Road – Sawbridge Road, Willoughby Road, Moor Lane, Main Street, London Road, Daventry Road, M45, Southam Road, Rugby Road, Napton Road, High Street, Stockton Road, Butt Hill, Shuckburgh Road and vice versa.

LEAMINGTON HASTINGS ROAD, BIRDINGBURY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside 3 Masters Court.

Reason for Order: To enable works for installation of new water connections.

Order Commences: 29 May 2024 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 31 May 2024.

Access & Diversion: Birdingbury Road, Southam Road, Rugby Road, Coventry Road, The Green, Marton Road, Oxford Road, Station Road, Leamington Hastings Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTHAM)

(20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2024

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the above-named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to reduce the 20 mph speed limit on the length of road described in the Schedule below. The length of road described in the Schedule below would instead be subject to a 30 mph speed limit by virtue of street lighting.
