

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2310 HOWCOMBE LANE, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2310 Howcombe Lane, Napton on the Hill between New Street and The Butts, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate drainage works.

The Order will commence on 11 January 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 January 2016.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2315 DOG LANE, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2315 Dog Lane, Napton on the Hill between Priors Marston Road and High Street, to vehicular traffic.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

(PART OF BRIDLEWAY W205 BADDESLEY CLINTON AND BEUSALE, HASLEY, HONILEY AND WROXALL) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2015

On 06/01/16, Warwickshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to **DIVERT** That section of Public Bridleway W205 from Point A (grid reference 42149 27126), west of Hay Wood Grange, travelling generally east south east for approximately 150 metres, then east north east for approximately 75 metres to Point B (grid reference 42171 27126) as shown on the Order Plan. **TO A LINE** From Point A (grid reference 42149 27126) the bridleway runs generally south east for approximately 175 metres to Point C (grid reference 42165 27120), then east north east for approximately 50 metres to Point D (grid reference 42170 27121), then north for approximately 45 metres to Point B (grid reference 42171 27126) as shown on the Order Plan.

The Order comes into force on 13/01/16, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or if any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 07/01/16, make an application to the High Court.
