

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984,

SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2315

DOG LANE, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2315 Dog Lane, Napton on the Hill between Priors Marston Road and High Street, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 27 January 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29 January 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: High Street, Hackwell Street, Vicarage Road, Butt Hill, Priors Marston Road (and in reverse order).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C50

NAPTON HOLT ROAD, MARSTON DOLES

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C50 Napton Holt Road, Marston Doles from Thorntons Lane to Welsh Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure was required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order commenced on 7 December 2015 for a period of 18 months, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier. Due to unforeseen circumstances the works were deferred.

The work has now been rescheduled to commence 1 February 2016 with anticipated completion of those works by 14 February 2015, weather permitting.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Welsh Road East, Daventry Road, Southam Road, Butt Hill, Vicarage Road, Hackwell Street, High Street, Chapel Green Road, Thorntons Lane (and in reverse order).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C35

HELLIDON ROAD, PRIORS MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C35 Hellidon Road, Priors Marston outside the property known as Woodland Rise, from the Marston Hill to the junction of Keyes Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate the installation of BT ducting.

The Order will commence on 25 January 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 February 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
