

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D2324 HIGH STREET, STOCKTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D2324 High Street, Stockton from the junction of Napton Road to a point outside property number 18, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate the connection of new water plots.

The Order will commence on 22 February 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 22 February 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C196 PRIORS MARSTON ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL
