Warwickshire Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing B4551 Station Road, Bishops Itchington, between B4452 Deppers Bridge County Council and Gaydon Road, to vehicular traffic

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 28 February 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 28 February 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via:

Deppers Bridges Road, Ufton Road, Southam Road, Ufton Hill, Southam Road, Fosse Way (B44550), Banbury Road, Gaydon Road, Station Road (and in reverse order).

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge (except when loading is prohibited) and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water

or electricity. A copy of the Order, together with a copy of an Order to be varied, a plan showing the length of road affected to be varied, a pieri strowing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; and at Warwick District Council, Riverside House Reception, Milverton

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
