

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PARK LANE, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Park Lane, Southam from the junction with Watton's Lane to the junction with Market Hill, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for the installation of a street lighting column.

The Order will commence on 27 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: St James Road, Welsh Road, Coventry Street and vice versa.

TACHBROOK ROAD NEAR ST GEORGE'S ROAD, LEAMINGTON SPA

Warwickshire County Council proposes to install traffic calming measures for the purpose of reducing the width pedestrians have to cross and to further improve the visibility of the crossing on Tachbrook Road near St George's Road, Leamington Spa as follows:

Footway build-out, a maximum of 2.4 metres wide, on the west side of Tachbrook Road for the length:

3 metres North of St Georges Road for a distance of 33 metres in a Northerly direction
