ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH HEATHER CLOSE, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing the public footpath in Heather Close, Southam from the junction of Heather Close to the junction with Ash Grove, to all traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate the installation of a street lighting column. The Order will commence on 1 March 2017 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 1 March 2017.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Coventry Street, Heather Close and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PARK LANE, SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Park Lane, Southam from the junction with Watton's Lane to the junction with Market Hill, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for the installation of a street lighting column.

The Order will commence on 27 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VICARAGE LANE, PRIORS MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Vicarage Lane, Priors Marston from its junction with Shuckburgh Road to its junction with Keys Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the rebuilding of a hydrant chamber.

The Order will commence on 15 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Keys Lane, Shuckburgh Road (and vice versa).

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A425 WARWICK-DAVENTRY ROAD AND B4451 KINETON ROAD, SOUTHAM) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2017

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to introduce a 30 mph speed limit on the length of road described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 27 February 2017.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of an Order to be varied, a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; at the Stratford on Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford upon Avon; and at the Public Library, Tithe Place, High Street, Southam during usual opening hours.

SCHEDULE

(30 mph Speed Limit by virtue of street lighting)

B4451 Kineton Road, Southam

That length of the B4451 Kineton Road which extends from its junction with the A425 Leamington Road, in a southerly and then south-westerly direction, to a point 245 metres south of the centreline of its junction with Westfield Road.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOLLY LANE, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Folly Lane, Napton on The Hill to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 1 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
