## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DOG LANE, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Dog Lane, Napton on the Hill from the junction with Fells Lane to the junction with Priors Marston Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a gabbion wall.

The Order will commence on 20 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Fells Lane, Vicarage Road, Butt Hill, Priors Marston Road and vice versa.

## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SOUTHAM EMERGENCY STOPPING PLACE) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2017 COMPULSORY PURCHASE OF LAND ADJACENT TO THE A425 DAVENTRY ROAD, SOUTHAM

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council has made the Warwickshire County Council (Southam Emergency Stopping Place) Compulsory Purchase Order 2017 under section 24(5) of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960. It is about to submit this order to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for confirmation, and if confirmed, the order will authorise the Warwickshire County Council to purchase compulsorily the land for the purpose of provide an emergency stopping place for up to 12 touring caravans and towing vehicles with associated facilities comprising:

- (i) 12 touring caravan pitches (marked out to a size of 6m x 2.4m) and 12 parking spaces for towing vehicles that would be marked out on an area of existing hard standing within the site;
- (ii) the provision of improved vehicular access points from the A425 into the site on its eastern and western boundaries with new access gates provided at both access points set back from the A425 to secure the site when not in use;
- (iii) the provision of a number of facilities for users of the site which will include portable toilet facilities, a number of waste refuse skips to dispose of waste generated on site would also be provided and located within the confines of the site and a fresh water standpipe to provide occupants with clean drinking water directly from a mains water supply.

Any objection to the order must be made in writing to the Head of Law and Governance, Warwickshire County Council before 5th April 2017 and should state the title of the order, the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land.

Three parcels of highway land (910 square metres, 2559 square metres and 1446 square metres in area) located to the east of Southam and adjoining the south side of the A425 Daventry Road.
