## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984. SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOP STREET. SOUTHAM

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Top Street, Southam to vehicular traffic

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of new water supplies.

The Order will commence on 18 September 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19 September 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Top Street, Northend Road, Blacksmiths Lane, Bottom Street, Peartrees, Malthouse Lane (and vice versa).

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A423 MARTON ROAD, LONG ITCHINGTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing A423 Marton Road, Long Itchington, from the junction with Leamington Road to the development access at Marton Road Farm, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing and marking.

The Order will commence on 17 September 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed on 17 September 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Southam Road, Coventry Road, Southam By Pass, Banbury Road, Leamington Road, Ufton Hill, Fosse Way, Hunningham Road, Oxford Road, Station Road, Marton Road, The Green (and vice versa).
